



# New or Replacement Player Checklist

**Please notify the club by NO LATER THAN 5.00PM on the THURSDAY before the game.. All replacement players MUST have their details confirmed on MyNetball prior to taking the court.**

## Is the replacement player eligible?

### 1) Does the player have VNA for the current year?

- a) If so, then number will need to be quoted on the scoresheet
- b) If not, then will need to have VNA before taking the court
  - i) Can obtain one-game VNA from the club or the Court Supervisor's Office
  - ii) A maximum number of three (3) Single Game Vouchers may be purchased by the player before the player must become a Netball Victoria member for the year.
  - iii) Or if player will be playing permanently, will need to pay for full year VNA via the Club only.

### 2) Is player the correct age for age group?

- a) Participant age is determined as at 31st December of that year.
  - i) Minimum age requirements are:
    - (a) 11 & U – 9 years
    - (b) 13&U – 11 years
    - (c) 15&U – 12 years
    - (d) 17&U – 14 years
    - (e) 25&U - 15 years

- 3) Has the player already played or been registered for another club at CDNA in the current season?**
- a) If so, even in a so-called “grading game”, then a clearance must be obtained from the club in question.
- 4) Has the player already played three games for another Ormond team in the current season?**
- a) Players may transfer between teams until the player takes the court for their third game with the one team. Once this occurs the player must remain with the team they played their third match with for the remainder of the Competition.
  - b) If in doubt, check the CDNA website.
- 5) Has the player already played for another Ormond team today?**
- a) A player may not play more than once on any round of the competition. The only exception to this rule will be at junior level (U13-U25) with the Court Supervisors’ approval, and only to make up the minimum amount of players five (5) to allow a team to field a side. If a 6th player takes the court because they were late then the player that was on the court to make up the 5 must leave the court immediately. The late player must fill the vacated position.
  - b) The only exception to this rule is with the Under 11 competition where it is to make up the 7th player and the Court Supervisor must give permission prior to taking the court.
  - c) Note that this rule could also apply to a player who filled in for another Ormond team prior to playing for their normal team on the same day, ie they could only play for their normal team on that day to make up the fifth player (but the earlier game would not be subject to the fifth player rule)
- 6) Can we get another player to fill in? (u11 & u13 only)**
- a) 11&U Competitions – Eligible boys participate unrestricted.
  - b) 13&U Competitions – Eligible boys will be permitted to play in this age group, but only one (1) boy is permitted to take the court at any one time. There is no limit to the number of boys named on the score sheet.
  - c) A player may not play more than once on any round of the competition (Friday & Saturday are considered the one competition).
    - i) The only exception to this rule will be at a junior level with the Court Supervisors’ approval, and only to make up the minimum amount of players five (5) to allow a team to field a side. If a 6th player takes the court because they were late then the player that was on the court to make up the 5 must leave the court immediately. The late player must fill the vacated position.
      - (1) **The only exception to this rule is with the Under 11 competition where it is to make up the 7th player and the Court Supervisor must give permission prior to taking the court.**
